
As you are aware, the Scituate Zoning Board of Appeals is formally requesting on behalf of the Town of Scituate a complete copy of all documents and work performed by BSC, its employees, for the Town of Scituate, and more particularly the Conservation Commission, relating to properties at 126 and 132 Chief Justice Cushing Hwy.

Presently, Herring Brook Meadow, LLC has filed a comprehensive permit application under M.G.L. 40B before the Zoning Board of Appeals. Under Chapter 40B, the Zoning Board is charged with the duty to review and decide the conservation issues. It is our understanding that applicant's engineer, SITEC, undertook environmental work at the above referenced site. It is my understanding that BSC was hired to review and evaluate the work in or about the Summer of 2004.
