A 40B application has been made for the above referenced site. I am having the applicant's engineer (SITEC) forward you a copy of the NOI submittal.

132 is a 14+ acre parcel with much of it is in the AE 11-foot zone.
126 is a 1+ acre parcel owned by Vinnie's wife. A 10,000+ gpd septic system is going there.

A significant fill (8 feet) is going in the AE zone.

Is there anyway possible we can get some technical assistance from CZM in reviewing the coastal flooding impacts. The V zone is very close to the site (Herring River through railway embankment), and I would imagine that there still could be some wave action that might be deflected on to neighboring properties. Our first hearing is tonight.
